

## ICY Checklist

**(ALL APPLICATIONS MUST CONTAIN THE ITEMS/MATERIAL LISTED BELOW. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.)**

- Submit a completed KSU CVM Instructional Clinical Year Application Form, International Applicant Form, along with a letter of intent describing their expectations from the program and their future professional goals.
- If applying for a Visa through Kansas State University, please submit a completed Affidavit of Support Form.
- Submit official transcripts from the veterinary school and undergraduate institution(s) attended by the applicant.
- Submit a certified photocopy of the candidate's diploma awarded by a college of veterinary medicine or its equivalent.
- Submit current curriculum vitae.
- Submit official test results for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the Test of Spoken English (TSE) OR the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) OR English proficiency may be assessed by department personnel if tests have not been completed.
- Submit at least three letters of recommendation from veterinarians that are graduates from AVMA accredited Colleges of Veterinary Medicine to be sent directly to KSU CVM who can adequately evaluate the applicant's potential clinical abilities.

- A non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 (bank check, money order, or cashier's check). The application fee must be submitted with the completed application form.
