(TP); Able to perform and interpret blood collection - jugulaar & tail; Able to perform and interpret California Mastitis Test (CMT)

*4th Year Core Procedures: All procedures required:* 4th Year Core (All): Local Anesthetic Techniques: Anesthesize an eye with an appropriate method for enucleation; Bier block; Caudal epidural (know appropriate dose); Cornual; Successfully anesthetize a Paralumbar Fossa with an approved method
