After graduating from KSU, I went to work for Athens Veterinary Service in Athens, WI, a 4 doctor, mixed animal practice in north central Wisconsin. I primarily focused on cattle and equine but also did small animal on the weekends and emergencies. This experience taught me how to be a veterinarian.

In 2004, we moved to Waupun, WI where I joined Waupun Veterinary Service, a 6 doctor primarily dairy clinic. In 2006, I made partner and we added two more doctors.
