OFFICIAL PROTOCOL

STUDENT EMERGENCY/ICU DUTY

A. Senior students will have after-hour emergency and/or ICU assignments in the following sections: Livestock Services, Anesthesia, Diagnostic Medicine, Small Animal Emergency, Equine, Radiology, Small Animal Medicine and Small Animal Surgery. The following applies to emergency duty.

- 1. See section specific protocols for exact duty times/shifts.
- 2. When students are "On Call", they must be available by phone and/or pager during their entire shift. Cell phone and pager numbers are provided to the Small Animal Discharge/Emergency Desk personnel. If students are called in to participate in an emergency, they are expected to be at the hospital within 15 minutes.
- 3. Students must always advise the faculty member in charge of the rotation **and/or** Section Head **and** Department Office immediately (in advance if possible) if for any reason they cannot be available for their assigned emergency/ICU duty, and students are required to find a substitute for their emergency duty. All duty changes must be submitted and approved in the Department Office between the hours of 8 A.M. 5 P.M. Monday through Friday. No duty changes may be made at the Small Animal Discharge/Emergency Desk after hours except in the case of extreme illness/injury or personal emergency. In these cases, the Department Office must be notified the next working day by the student.
