COURSES REQUIRED

Clinical Anesthesiology	3 weeks
Clinical Small Animal Orthopedic Surgery	3 weeks
Clinical Small Animal Soft Tissue Surgery	3 weeks
Dentistry	1 week
Diagnostic Medicine	3 weeks
Equine Med. or Equine SX or Equine Field Serv.	4 weeks (choose 2 of the 3)
Food Animal Local Practice	2 weeks
Food Animal Medicine & Surgery	2 weeks
Ophthalmology	2 weeks
Small Animal Emergency	2 weeks
Small Animal Internal Medicine	3 weeks
Small Animal General Medicine	3 weeks
Vet Diagnostic Imaging I (Radiology)	3 weeks
Electives	11 weeks

The fourth-year curriculum is based on approximately 52 weeks per year with nine rotations; rotations being either: 1, 2, 3, or 4 weeks in duration. The core courses will occupy 34 of the 52-week year. The remaining 18 weeks are to be used for 11 weeks of required electives/externships and vacation.
