The fourth-year curriculum is based on approximately 52 weeks per year with nine rotations; rotations being either: 1, 2, 3, or 4 weeks in duration. The core courses will occupy 34 of the 52-week year. The remaining 18 weeks are to be used for 11 weeks of required electives/externships and vacation.
