MRI \$2 million

The VHC currently uses refurbished MRI equipment, however, upgraded equipment would give us the ability to image large animals and diagnose diseases of the brain and spinal cord.

CT Multi-slice \$350,000

The CT used at the VHC is a single slice meaning less area is able to be imaged at one time. A multi-slice CT unit would enhance diagnostic capability and enhance clinical research in the VHC. Radiologists at the VHC have excellent research potential, but are limited by equipment capabilities.

Upgrade Diagnostic Workstation \$15,000

Students and faculty would benefit from upgrades to computers and other equipment in the diagnostic workstations. Equipment to better facilitate teaching and hands-on experience is critical to the goals of the hospital.

Monitor for Rounds Room \$3,000

Students and Faculty spend a significant amount of time discussing cases in rounds. A large digital monitor would make images much easier for students to evaluate.
