

Signalment:

Species: Equine

Breed: Paint

Sex: Gelding

Age: 11 yrs.

Presenting Complaint and History:

5 month history of right hind limb lameness. Has received multiple injections of hyaluronic acid as well as corticosteroids in both hocks, the last occurring 4 months prior to presentation.

Physical Exam:

- Palpable effusion in fetlocks of both hind limbs
- Palpable bony proliferation in both hocks
- Right-sided gluteal atrophy

Plan:

- Flexion tests –
 - positive response to flexion in hock and fetlock of both hind limbs
- Diagnostic nerve blocks of right hind limb –
 - negative response to abaxial, low four point, and tarsometatarsal/distal intertarsal joint block.
 - Improves 50% to high four point, and peroneal/tibial nerve block

Radiographs:
